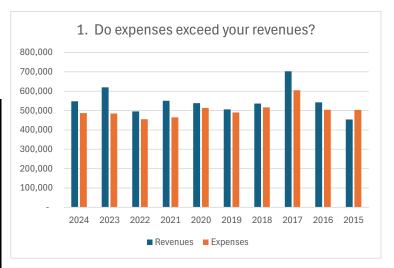
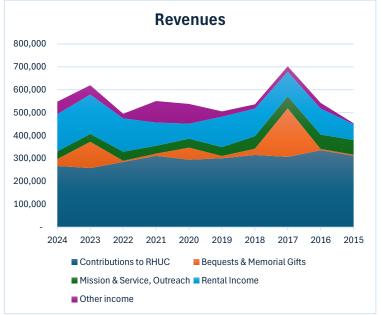

Comments

In 2020 and 2021 Other income includes CEWS, most of which was not received until 2021. The church also received \$39,000 as a special gift from a current member which was treated as a living bequest.

Once capital repairs and additions shown at Q5 below are taken into account expenses are consistent from year to year except that in 2020 expenses fell due to the building being closed and in 2016 the church went from two full-time ministers to one.

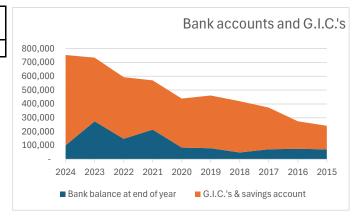

\$48,633 of the Special Gifts Fund comes from a bequest which stated the funds were to be used at the discretion of the Special Gifts Committee and not be applied to current budget deficits but applied to the restoration of the organ, Memorial Founders Window or such other extra demands that the said Committee deems appropriate.

Currently this fund is being used to fund the Mission Action Plan, and in particular the property development project. During 2020 amounts in the fund were used for consultants working with RHUC on the Mission Action Plan. The remaining \$34,000 in this fund is for music, the organ, Multifaith Initiatives, Youth, Net Zero, Shalom Seekers, and the UCW.

Note B - Contributions by age group
